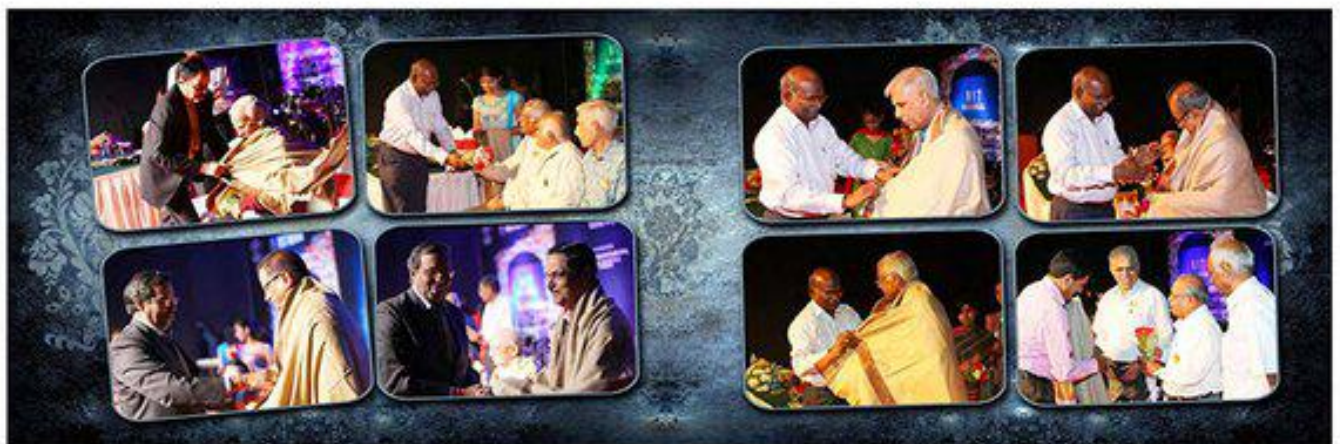

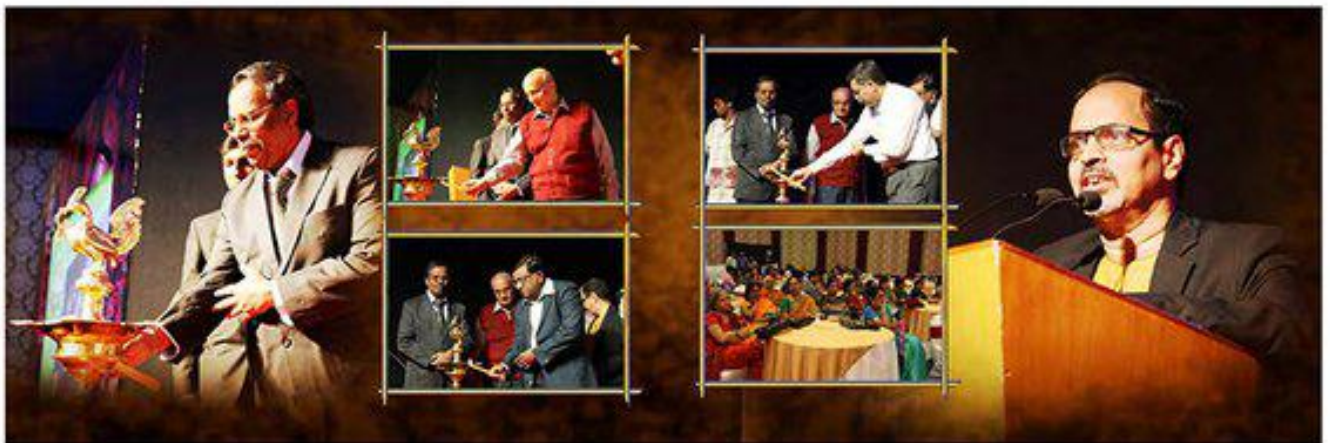

## *Inception of Inter REC Sports Meet-1967*

During the early months of 1966-67, we were summoned by our dear principal Group Captain NJ Kriplani to his residence. Myself, R I Singh and G.B Singh met him; and we had a sigh of relief when we came to know that the matter was neither serious nor it was concerned with any disciplinary action for which we were used to.

To our surprise, the principle threw the idea of conducting the first ever Inter REC sports meet and advised that this should take place this year itself, even if it has to be done on a small scale.

We came back discussing the whole issue and met our Physical Education Director Mr Simon John, Mr Srihari and Mr Sashtri garu (sports in charge) and then General Captain, Mr Mathew and informed about the idea of our principal. A full fledged meeting of all the captains of various games and Sports dept. was called in by principle. All the participants were very enthusiastic about the meet but we did not have good sports facilities. Only football ground, Badminton court, Tennis court and volley ball court were ready at that time with. We did not have facilities to accommodate host and participants of the meet. So it was decided that we conduct only tennis, shuttle badminton and table tennis tournament and next year include volleyball and basket ball.



Being the college captains of these games, we had to take full responsibility of organizing and inviting the colleges even though the overall responsibility was with the sports department. We sent invitations through letters to all other REC's of that time. The communication system was not as efficient as it is today and we had to communicate through trunk calls and letters which was time consuming.

We were delighted to receive confirmation for the participation of Nagpur, Rourkela, Durgapur, Jamshedpur and Srinagar, who ultimately took part in the meet. As most of students were busy with studies, very few were excited about the forthcoming meet. It would be fair to mention the names of few of the athletes like Mr Ummat, Shenoy brothers, Randheer Reddy, Krishan raj, Rajsekhar, Srinivasan, G.D singh, Sebastian, Major Singh, Linga Reddy, Babbar, Singh brothers from Malaysia and many others. They all will be in their late sixties and early seventies now and they have done very well in life.

The arrangement was that TT matches will be held in the 2nd floor, common hall of drawing classes in Admin building (only building) by making good lighting arrangement and bringing floor to good shape. As there was no badminton hall, we made a make shift court with cow dung surface adjacent to three seater hostel, as three sides were enclosed and the fourth was covered with a tarpaulin curtain to avoid wind creating problems for the players, proper lighting was done also. Two new tennis courts were laid which was a big challenge as the surface had to be playable with proper lighting arrangements.

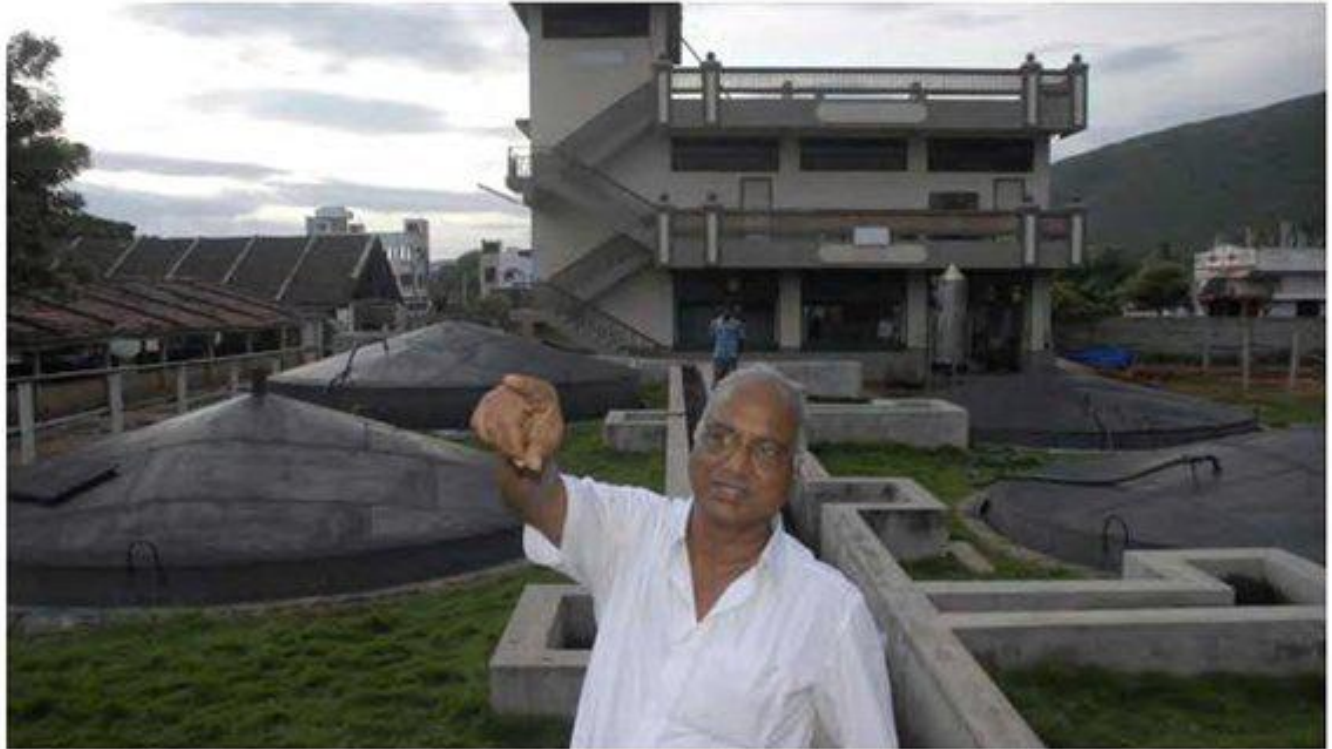

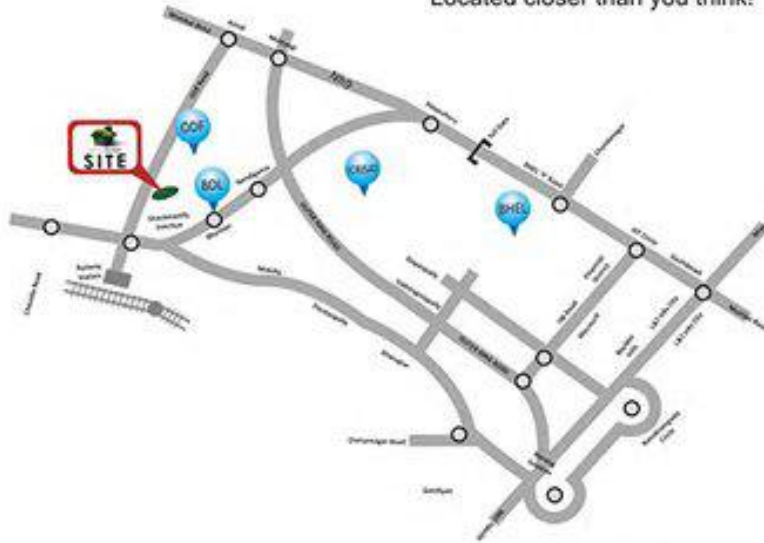

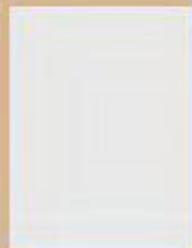
